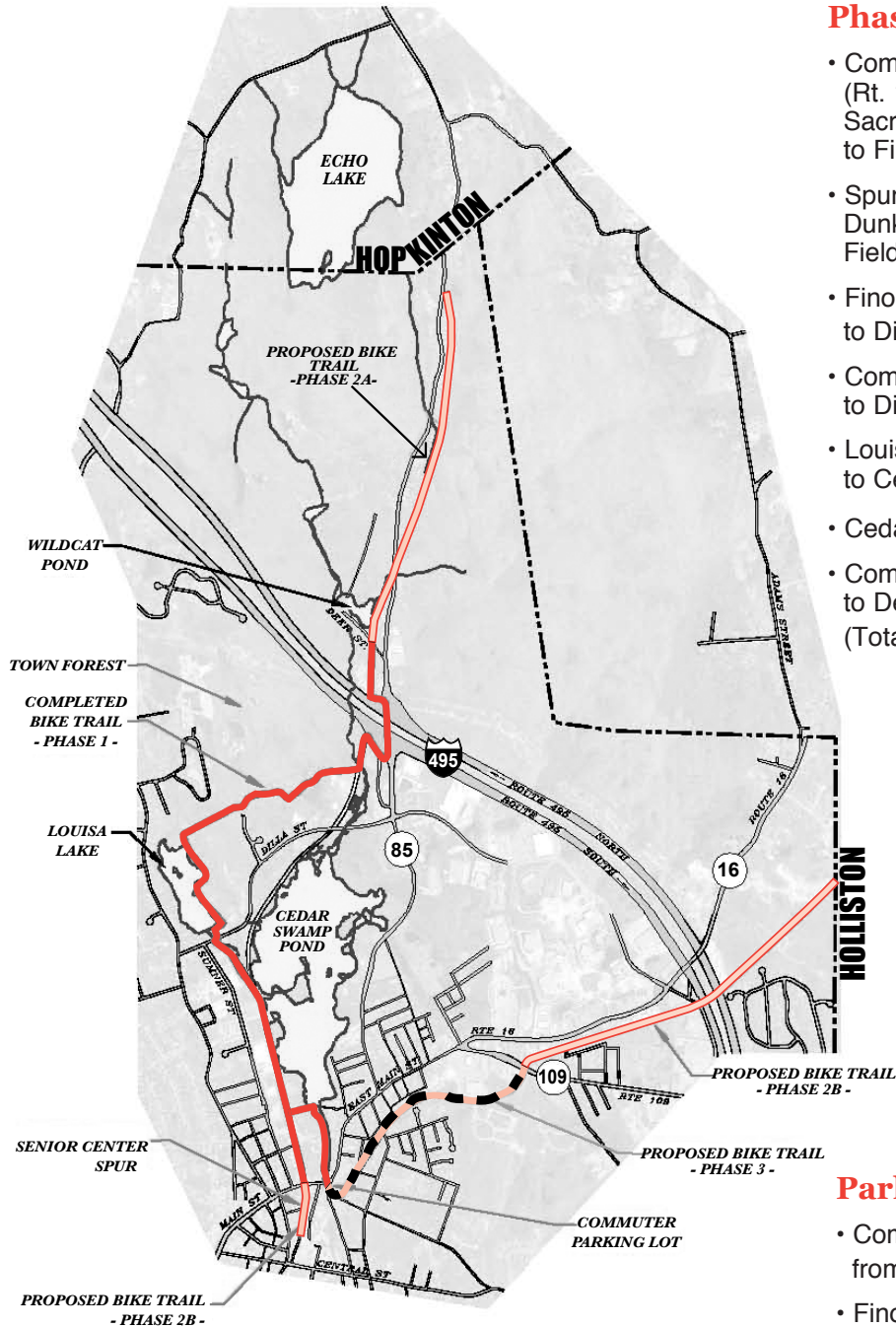

Phase 1 Trail Lengths

- Commuter Parking Lot (Rt. 16 across from Sacred Heart Church) to Fino Field Intersection...**0.3mile**
- Spur from Rt. 16 Dunkin Donuts to Fino Field Intersection...**0.25 mile**
- Fino Field Intersection to Dilla Street.....**0.7 mile**
- Commuter Parking Lot to Dilla Street.....**1.0 miles**
- Louisa Lake Parking Lot to Cedar Street.....**1.4 miles**
- Cedar Street to Deer Street..**0.4 mile**
- Commuter Parking Lot to Deer Street (Total Phase 1).....**2.8 miles**

- Commuter Lot on Rt. 16 across from Sacred Heart Church
- Fino Field Recreation Area at the end of Granite St.
- Louisa Lake lot on Dilla St.

TRAIL OVERVIEW

The Milford Upper Charles Trail is a three phase project approximately 6.8 miles long that runs through Milford from the Holliston town line to the vicinity of the Hopkinton line. Phase 1 is a completed 2.8 mile long segment starting at the Commuter Parking Lot on Main Street and traveling north to Deer Street, just north of the Route 495 interchange.

Phase 2 is at the final design stage. It is comprised of two segments (2A and 2B) totaling approximately 3 miles. Phase 2A completes the trail from Deer Street to the vicinity of the Hopkinton town line. Phase 2A also includes a segment from Dunkin Donuts on Main Street to the Senior Center on North Bow Street. Phase 2B completes the segment of trail from the Route 109/Veterans Memorial Drive intersection to the Holliston town line.

The Phase 3 segment is at the initial planning stage and is approximately 1 mile long. It will complete the trail from Route 109/Veterans Memorial Drive intersection back to the Commuter Parking Lot on Main Street thereby creating a convenient non-motorized unbroken trail through the town that also provides access to Louisa Lake, Milford Pond and the adjacent open space, as well as to the Town Forest.

The trail offers a rich variety of experiences: spectacular views of the lake and pond, quiet woodland trails, small parks, and sitting areas along the lake. It also represents a means to enhance and preserve wildlife habitat by creating a continuous wildlife corridor.

TRAIL ACTIVITIES

Trail activities include biking, walking, running, and rollerblading. In winter, the path can be used for X-C skiing and snow shoeing. Well behaved leashed dogs are allowed on the trail and their owners are responsible for cleaning up after them.
